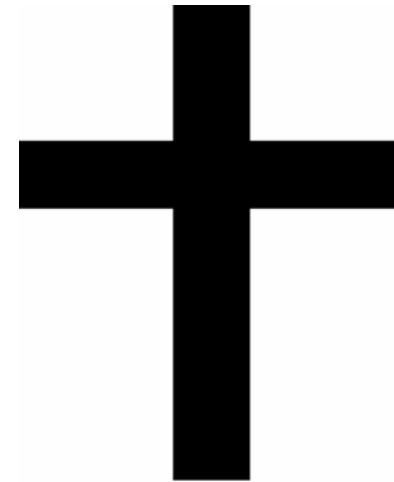
Eternal Father, strong to save
